

## **Barnes Fasteners**

Know the Right Fastener for Your Task

Sometimes you need more than a simple screw or nail. More complex tasks require more complex fasteners. Here are some suggestions.

Fasten structural wood-to-wood connections with heavy **bolts**. Always use a **washer** to reduce pressure. Bolts without tapered ends should be secured with a **nut**. **Anchors** hold screws or bolts in weak materials.

There's more to know about bolts, though. Know what **grade** to buy. And check if you need **UTS** thread or metric thread.

Smaller fasteners are equally useful. **Brads** are great for hanging pictures or other household tasks. And **staples** are not just for paper! For example, large ones attach shingles to a roof.
